YARD MAINTENANCE

A clean and well-maintained neighborhood benefits everyone, so please assist in preserving our neighborhood value by following this simple criteria provided by the Woodland Creek HOA Covenants Committee.

- Mow grass every week to ten days;
- Yards fertilized and weed control on a routine basis;
- Sidewalks and driveways routinely edged;
- Shrubbery neatly trimmed;
- Any part of the driveway visible from the street free from clutter;
- Dead grass and shrubbery removed and/or replaced.



PET PROTOCOL

As always, please be courteous and pick up after your pets. It's more than being considerate; dog poop could damage your beautiful lawn! Pet urine and feces can be a frustrating lawn care problem. Remember to be courteous to your neighbors and make sure you have a plastic bag in tow when walking your pet. **PICK UP THE POOP!**
